## The Riverside Group

### About The Riverside Group

The Riverside Group was established in 1928 as Liverpool Improved Houses. The Group has grown significantly over the past few years following a number of mergers and acquisitions, as well as stock transfers from Local Authorities. Riverside now owns or manages around 40,000 houses from Carlisle to the Midlands and they have plans to expand by up to 60,000 properties.

### Requirements

Following a period of tremendous growth, Riverside had amalgamated a number of Head Office functions, housing stock and employees in a short period of time. They identified a need for specialist Health & Safety knowledge and expertise to help them develop and implement their corporate Health & Safety policy, standardise Health & Safety across their diverse range of schemes, minimise risks and ensure they remain fully compliant with government legislation. Riverside initially considered employing someone in-house to tackle this area, but decided that using external consultants would give them access to a much deeper level of expertise and experience.
